Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

1. to act as an authentic, international body for the collection of Scottish historical relicts, particularly those related to Clan Strachan;
2. to collect, collate and record these items and be responsible for their housing and preservation.
3. to encourage the study, interest, and research into Scottish history, particularly that of the Strachan family; and
4. to support other charities, museums, galleries in furtherance of these aims.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The Trustees have recently received notification of approval of its Minute Variation of Trust, dated 19 February 2018; and Deed of Assumption. Trustees have commenced planning for fund raising and a preliminary search for property to house and safeguard relics in Strachan, Aberdeenshire. The Trust is closely associated with the Clan Strachan Scottish Heritage Society, which is a public charity registered in the United States. Both the Trust and Society are planning a Clan Gathering in 2019 to coincide with the Aboyne Games, which will provide symposiums on local, Clan, and Scottish history.

Additional Trustees have recently been added per the Deed of Assumption. Entering planning stage for 2019 Clan Strachan Gathering in or near Strachan, Aberdeenshire to coincide with the Aboyne Highland Games in early August.
